Review process introduction interqual the acute pediatric rehabilitation criteria are for children younger than 18 years of age. important: the criteria reflect clinical interpretations and analyses and cannot alone either resolve medical ambiguities of particular situations or provide the sole basis for definitive decisions. the criteria are intended solely for use as screening guidelines evaluate the appropriateness of patient care across the continuum. interqual® level of care criteria help healthcare organizations assess the safest and most clinically appropriate care level for more than 95% of reasons for admission. interqual® outpatient rehabilitation & chiropractic criteria support decisions about the appropriateness of therapy services and chiropractic care in the outpatient setting. outpatient rehabilitation & chiropractic criteria subsets have been validated for use with adult, adolescent, or pediatric patients.
