cultivation theory examines the long-term effects of television. "the primary proposition of cultivation theory states that the more time people spend 'living' in the television world, the more likely they are to believe social reality aligns with reality portrayed on television."adolescence (from latin adolescere, meaning 'to grow up') is a transitional stage of physical and psychological development that generally occurs during the period from puberty to legal adulthood (age of majority)e facts on tweens and teens, and dating violence while dating, domestic and sexual violence affect women regardless of their age, teens and young women areit is believed that repeated exposure to real-life and to entertainment violence may alter cognitive, affective, and behavioral processes, possibly leading to desensitizatione life of a teenager seems to change daily. one minute a teen seems interested in a new sport, topic in school, or type of music, only to completely shift gears the next.emerging issues facing tweens and teens . young people, 12 to 19 years old, experience the highest rates of rape and sexual assault, i. youth,18 to 19
